



Recycling Saves Natural Resources

Seventeen trees are saved for every ton of paper recycled. In 2006, Urbana's residential and multifamily U•CYCLE programs recycled 1,918 tons of mixed paper, saving 32,606 trees!



Recycling Creates Jobs

On a per-ton basis, sorting and processing recyclables creates 10 times more jobs than landfilling or incineration. In Illinois, recycling has created jobs for more than 56,000 people.

FUN FACT

In 2006 Urbana's U•CYCLE programs reduced greenhouse gas emissions by 1,896 metric tons, the equivalent of removing 1,331 passenger cars from the road!

Did you Know ?



Recycling one ton of glass saves the equivalent of 10 gallons of oil. Urbana's U•CYCLE programs recycled 509 tons of glass in 2006, saving 5,090 gallons of oil!



Recycling Reduces Water Pollution

Every ton of recycled paper saves 7,000 gallons of water. Urbana's U•CYCLE programs saved over 13 million gallons of water in 2006 and reduced pollution by 12.3 tons.



Recycling Conserves Energy

Recycling one aluminum can saves enough energy to run a TV for 3 hours. Urbana's U•CYCLE programs recycled 38 tons of aluminum in 2006, enough energy savings to run a TV for 198 hours in every Urbana household!



Recycling Reduces Air Pollution

Every ton of recycled paper keeps 60 pounds of air pollution out of our atmosphere. In 2006, Urbana's U•CYCLE programs kept over 115,000 pounds of air pollution out of the atmosphere.
